



2010 Lacrosse Registration

Welcome to registration for the 2010 lacrosse season. We are glad you want to play lacrosse with us and this sheet will guide you through the registration process. Forms You Must Complete

Registration Form – Please complete the form in its entirety. Make your check payable to SVLA for your registration balance due. (Cost is shown below)

SV Student athletic Manual Cover Page – Player and Parent(s) / Guardian must read and sign

SVLA Student Health Record and Emergency Procedures – Parent / Guardian complete, sign 2 Copies

SVLA Insurance Waiver – Parent / Guardian must complete and sign

PIAA Comprehensive Initial Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation - 7/8, JV and Varsity ONLY – completed by a physician Must Complete Before the First Official Practice no exceptions!

- **An athletic physical must be obtained on or after June 1, 2009**, and is good for the entire school year.
- A private Authorized Medical Examiner or the school doctor must administer physicals.
- School physicals are performed in the Senior High School for a \$15 fee (cash or check payable to S.V.S.D.). Dates and times are available at www.svsd.net/athletics/sports-info, or contact the Athletic Office.
- Only 1 Physical is required per year, with parental re-certification approval (CIPPE Section 5) for each subsequent sport, unless the athlete suffers a serious illness or injury.
- **CIPPE Sections 1, 2 & 3** - Parents must complete these sections for the initial sport.
- **CIPPE Section 4** – A private Authorized Medical Examiner or the school doctor must complete this section for an initial sport. Forms must be dated on or after June 1, 2009.
- **CIPPE Section 5** – This is the re-certification form and must be completed by the parent and athlete for each subsequent sport. (No doctor's signature required.)
- **CIPPE Section 6** – This section needs to be filled out by your family or school doctor **ONLY IF** the student athlete has sustained a serious illness or injury since the initial evaluation.
- **CIPPE Section 7** – Not required for Lacrosse

Boys in grades 7–12 MUST have a drug screen on file that was administered during the 09-10 school year.

All forms must be completed and received by SVLA prior to the first practice for your son to participate in Lacrosse

Uniform deposit 3rd – 8th Grade: \$100.00 (postdated check dated 6/1/2010 This check will be returned at the end of the season with complete uniform return) All players

Uniform deposit 9th – 12th Grade: \$150.00 (postdated check dated 6/1/2010 This check will be returned at the end of the season with complete uniform return) All players

Fund Raiser: \$100.00 Book of tickets (numbers based on the lottery) to sell or keep. One set of tickets per family. This is mandatory

Uniform: Supplied by the association for ALL players. High School Uniforms include Helmet

Equipment: Players must purchase their own equipment including but not limited to a lacrosse helmet, and face mask (youth and middle school only, high school helmets are part of the uniform), mouth guard, shoulder and arm pads, athletic support and cup, lacrosse stick, lacrosse gloves and cleats. Expect that some games may be played on turf where basketball type shoes should be worn.

Apparel Sales: Will be available during registration and at other times during the season.

US Lacrosse Number – Boys who have participated in Lacrosse prior to this registration period will already have a US Lacrosse Number. It can be found on the US Lacrosse magazine that you receive. If you cannot find your number you may contact me at schreib@ptlp.com or I can let you know what it is at registration. New players will be assigned a number in January 2010 so just leave the number blank. When you receive your first magazine the number will show on the address label. Players who register late and are accepted into the program will be responsible for getting their own US Lacrosse Number and paying the \$25.00 fee to US Lacrosse. Players who register during the registration period are provided this number as part of their registration fee. Every player must have a US Lacrosse Number for insurance reasons.

Players who register after Thursday, October 29, 2009 will be placed on a waiting list. If space is available on a team they will be notified as quickly as possible.
